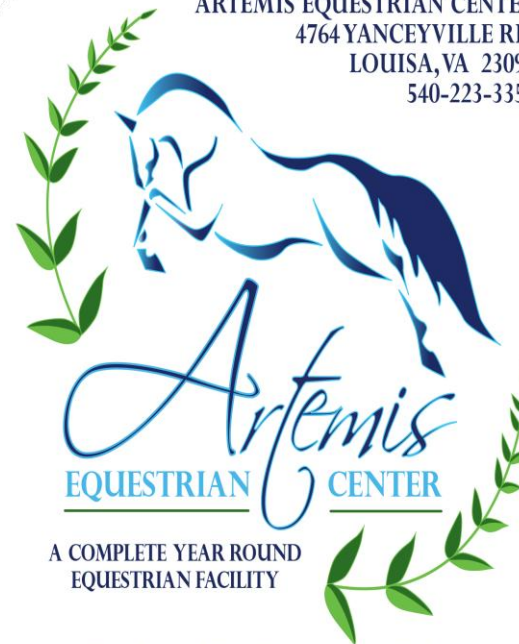

Division Specification

California Warm –Up- An un-judged warm-up round may be ridden prior to your judged class. Course B open all day.

Lead line – Open to all riders, to be judged 50% rider equitation/50% suitability of mount. Riders may not cross enter into any other class except #2.

Walk Trot Equitation – Open to any rider not showing over fences. To be judged on equitation. Will be divided by age if entries warrant. May trot or canter over poles.

Beginner Rider – Open to all riders who have not shown over 2'. May trot or canter O/F. Will not canter in large group

Green As Grass Hunter – Open to all horses who have not shown over 2' May trot or canter O/F

Short - Long Stirrup Equitation – Open to all riders, to be judged on equitation. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which they jump over 18". May trot or canter O/F.

Short – Long Stirrup Hunter – Open to all horses and riders not competing over 18" May trot or canter O/F.

Student Rider Equitation – Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2' or higher. Judged on equitation.

Pleasure – Open to all horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, soundness, and manners. Entries may be split if warrant.

Maiden Hunter – Open to horses or ponies in their first year of showing over fences at 2' or higher. May trot or canter O/F

Pony Hunter – Open to all ponies, Jr. riders. The division will be split to sm./med and large ponies if entries warrant. Sm. jump 2', Med. jump 2'3", Large 2'6".

Low Hunter – Open to horses and ponies: No restrictions on riders. Fence height of 2' – 2'3"

Children/Adult Equitation – Open to juniors or adults on horses or ponies not showing in pony division. Fence height 2'3", division to be split if entries warrant.

Schooling Hunter – Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fence height 2'6" – 2'9".

Working Hunter – Open to all horses and ponies not entered in a pony division. Fence height 3'.

Champion & Reserve awarded in each division.

End of series Grand Champion & Grand Reserve prizes & ribbons awarded at the completion of series (at last show)

Points as follows:

1st – 10 points

2nd – 6 points

3rd – 4 points

4th – 2 points

5th – 1 point

6th – ½ point

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL, COMBINE OR DIVIDE AS NEEDED
2. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST WEAR ASTM/SEI PROTECTIVE HELMETS WITH HARNESS FASTENED AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.
3. CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS DATED WITHIN 12 MONTHS REQUIRED. BRING A COPY TO LEAVE WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY.
4. PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED. JACKETS MAY BE EXCUSED AT JUDGE'S DISCRETION.
5. HUNTER CLASSES TO BE JUDGED ON SOUNDNESS AND PERFORMANCE ANY ADDITIONAL SPECIFICATIONS WILL BE NOTED. TROPHY AND 8 RIBBONS AWARDED IN EVERY CLASS
6. HUNTER COURSE INCLUDES GATE, BRUSH, WALLS, OXERS, COOPS, RAILS OR ANY COMBINATION THEREOF. JUMPER COURSES SAME
7. ANY AND ALL VISITING ANIMALS ARE REQUIRED TO BE LEASHED
8. EVERY ANIMAL ENTERED FOR COMPETITION OR ON SHOW GROUNDS SHALL BE UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE. ARTEMIS EQUESTRIAN CENTER AND/OR ITS EMPLOYEES SHALL NOT BE LIABLE OR RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE TO ANY ANIMAL, PERSON OR PROPERTY, WHICH MAY OCCUR FOR ANY REASON DURING THE SHOW AND IT SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY THAT EACH EXHIBITOR HOLD ARTEMIS EQUESTRIAN CENTER, ITS OWNERS AGENTS, EMPLOYEES AND THE USEF BLAMELESS FOR ANY ACCIDENT OR LOSS WHICH MAY OCCUR.
